1. Preventive Measures

Dirt that is usually carried into a building can be avoided by fitting barrier matting in the entrance areas or by incorporating these areas into routine cleaning procedures.

2. Routine Cleaning and Care

Daily cleaning should be carried out using a well wrung-out mop and a diluted neutral detergent such as Jontec 501. The floor should then be allowed to dry normally.

The LL300 should not be over-wetted during cleaning and any spillages should be cleaned up as soon as possible.

NB Jontec 501 is a cleaning agent that disinfects and has been developed to protect general hard and non-porous surfaces. It is available from Johnson Diversey; other similar products are widely available.

3. Periodical Deep Cleaning

More intensive maintenance should be carried out every 3 or 4 months depending on the amount of traffic. This should be done with a spray buffing machine (contact pad or blue floor pad) using, for example, P44 or Stride 2000 from Johnson Diversey.
